Toddlers and Preschool Rooms 1-5: A full day- 9:00 AM to 3:00 PM A half day- 9:00 AM to 12:00 PM

Elementary classrooms Rooms 6 &7: A full day is 8:30 AM to 2:30 PM

We offer morning daycare from 7:00 AM to 8:45 AM and afternoon daycare from 3:00 PM to 6:00 PM for an additional charge. To properly staff, we need to know in advance if you need daycare for your child. We do offer occasional daycare at a rate of \$20 per hour.



You will be able to self-register prior to your child's picture day, and your orders will arrive directly at your homes. We are looking forward to all these adorable pictures!

Tuition Billing

Tuition installments are due on the <u>15th of every month prior to</u> <u>attendance</u> (i.e., the first installment is due on the date of enrollment, the second installment is due on September 15th for October, the third installment is due on October 15th for November, and so forth). We will debit the accounts of those families who have signed up for Tuition Express on the 15th of every month. If the 15th of any month falls on a weekend, your account will be charged the Friday before. It takes two days to process and credit to our account. If tuition is not received by the 20th of the month, a \$50 late charge will be applied. If tuition is not received by the first of the month, the child will be dropped from the program.

Emergency Procedures

Each class will be practicing Fire/Earthquake Drills. Once a month, we will be going into each classroom unannounced to practice with the children and staff. In addition to Fire/ Earthquake Preparedness, we are also preparing our staff and facility in the event of a biological or chemical threat. Additionally, we have upgraded our security systems and have had staff training on how to respond to an intruder or emergency situation. In the event of an emergency evacuation, our school would meet at The Trinity Catholic Church on Corporate Drive. If this location was not possible, a note would be posted on our front door listing our location. We carry an emergency book with all the children's emergency information with us while practicing our drills. In order to be adequately prepared for an emergency, we require that each parent purchase an Econo Kit for \$25 for your child. These kits will be stored in the children's classrooms.

Drop-Off and Pick-Up Policies

Please remember to sign your child in and out daily via the Procare Connect app on your phone OR from the tablets located in the hallway! This is a Licensing requirement and for safety reasons, is important to follow. Parents, please advise all other authorized pickup people to sign your child out on the tablets.

Reminder of our Illness Policy

Please **DO NOT** send your child to school if he/she has a fever, vomiting, diarrhea, or colored mucus. In addition, he/she must be free of these symptoms for a *complete* 24 hours before returning to school. Your child must be picked up by the parent or authorized person within 30 minutes of notification that your child has become ill at school.

Reminder about Nap Policy

It is a State Requirement that we, as a school, do not deny or force any child to nap. Every child in rooms 1 through 5 will have a 30-minute rest period on a cot while listening to a story or music. At the end of the 30-minute rest period, those children who have not fallen asleep will be taken out to the playground and then brought back into the classroom for quiet work time.

Medication Policy

We can administer any medication or epi-pen that is prescribed by a physician for your child, with a signed medication permission form. Stop by the front office to pick up these forms, if necessary.

No Toy Policy

In keeping with our "No Toy" Policy, we are asking you to help us by making sure your children leave all toys at home. Please encourage them to bring things like books, photographs, collectibles, etc., to share with their class. Please contact your teacher regarding what day is share day in your child's classroom.
